3. Application Qualifications

In addition to the general eligibility requirements, there are also some specific requirements that individual applications must meet. However, if you wish to enroll in October 2024, the date "March 31, 2024" in the following items shall be changed to "September 30, 2024. For details of the application conditions, please refer to the relevant page of each division's admission procedures. Applicants must meet one of the following criteria.

Applicants should:

- ① have graduated or are expected to graduate from a university as stipulated in Article 83 of the School Education Law (Law No. 26 of 1947) by March 31, 2024
- ② have been conferred a bachelor's degree pursuant to the provisions of Article 104, Paragraph 7 of the School Education Law, or individuals who are expected to receive a bachelor's degree by March 31, 2024
- 3 have completed or are expected to complete 16 years of school education in a foreign country by March 31, 2024
- 4 have completed or are expected to complete a course of study at an educational institution in Japan that has been designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as having a foreign university curriculum by March 31, 2024
- ⑤ have completed or are expected to complete 16 years of school education in Japan via correspondence courses offered by a school abroad by March 31, 2024
- 6 have completed a course of three years or longer at a university or other foreign school (limited to those that have been evaluated by third party and is accredited by the government of the host country or a relevant organization regarding the comprehensive status of its educational and research activities, etc., or those designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as being equivalent thereto) those who have received a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree or are expected to receive a bachelor's degree by March 31, 2024.
- (7) be a person designated eligible by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology,
- ® have completed or are expected to complete a specialized training college (limited to those that meet the criteria specified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, such as a training period of 4 years or longer) by March 31, 2024
- (9) have been admitted to a graduate school other than this graduate school pursuant to the provisions of Article 102, Paragraph 2 of the School Education Law, and who are recognized by this graduate school as having the academic ability suitable for receiving education at the graduate level.
- 10 have attended or are expected to attend a university for three years or more by March 31,

2024, as stipulated by Article 83 of the School Education Law: applicants who have completed or are expected to complete a 15-year school education course in a different country or a 15-year school distance education course hosted in a different country by March 31, 2024

Those who wish to apply according to (6), (9), (10), or (11) of "3. Application Qualifications" must complete the eligibility screening prior to the application period and deadlines. (3) Payment of application fee

The entrance examination fee is 30,000 yen.

Please fill out the bank transfer request form attached to this application guideline and make the transfer at a financial institution (bank, credit union, credit cooperative, agricultural cooperative, or fishery cooperative) that allows money transfers at the teller window. Applicants are required to pay the bank transfer fees.

Please note that financial institutions are closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays. In addition, transfers from Japan Post Bank, post offices, ATMs (Automated Teller Machines), cell phones, and personal computers will not be accepted.

[Refund of application fee]

In principle, the application fee is not refundable after the application documents are received. However, applicants may apply for a refund, if you cancel your application after transferring the application fee. Please contact the university by Friday, September 29, 2023, for the first term admission and by Friday, March 8, 2024, for the second term admission. Please note that a "receipt (copy for the applicant)" and a "certificate of bank transfer (for submission)" will be required for the return procedure.

7. Admission Categories • Examination Schedule

Admission process of applicants includes a comprehensive evaluation of academic achievements, written and oral examinations, research proposals, and grades from the applicant's home university. The selection method and examination dates for each major are as follows:

I. Undergraduate Applicants

《Division of Production System Science》

The admission process for the undergraduate applicants for the Division of Production System Science consists of Examination 1 and Examination 2.

Applicants who meet all the requirements for Examination 1, will be exempted from taking Examination2, and will be evaluated by an oral examination and an external English Language proficiency test. Examination 2 procedures are discussed on page 3 of this guide and include an academic achievement test, oral examinations, and a review of an external English Language proficiency test score.

*If applicants are unsuccessful in Examination 1, they will be required to take Examination 2.

1. Requirements for Examination 1

- Applicants who meet the following conditions described in (1) through (5) may take the examination.
- Applicants must notify the Division Head before the application period and deadlines. (See page 21 of this document for contact information.)
- (1) Applicants who are expected to graduate from a university by March 31, 2024, as stipulated in Article 83 of the School Education Law (Law No. 26, 1947).
- (2) Applicants who are expected to receive a bachelor's degree by March 31, 2024, pursuant to Article 104, Paragraph 7 of the School Education Law.
- (3) Applicants who have an excellent academic record (*1) and a good reputation in the department to which they belong.
 - (*1) A GPA of 2.4 or higher in principle, based on a 5-point scale with 4 being the highest score, or a grade average within the top 1/2 of the department in general.
 - (In case GPA is not available in the submitted transcripts, the GPA will be calculated based on the submitted data in accordance with Komatsu University's academic regulations.)
- (4) Applicants who can commit to enrolling in the Graduate School program if accepted (A letter of commitment must be submitted by the designated date.)
- (5) Applicants who have obtained permission to take Examination 1 from the Division Head before the application period and deadlines, by providing the following information:


